WHAT IS Project DC?

REACH is a community-based residential program for pre-adjudicated young men ages 12 to 17 referred by the D.C. Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services. Renovation efforts will focus on enhancing a homelike environment for the young residents of REACH, while also creating spaces to support the home's mission to provide residential care, counseling, and life skills development activities in a family-style involvement.

Founded in 1974, Sasha Bruce Youthwork provides direct and preventative services to realize the vision of a community where homelessness is brief, rare, nonrecurring, or non-existent, and all youth and families have access to the tools and resources they deserve to thrive.

SBY's REACH home offers residential care, counseling, and life skills development activities, including educational and employment pportunities, for an average of 100 youth annually in a family-style involvement.
